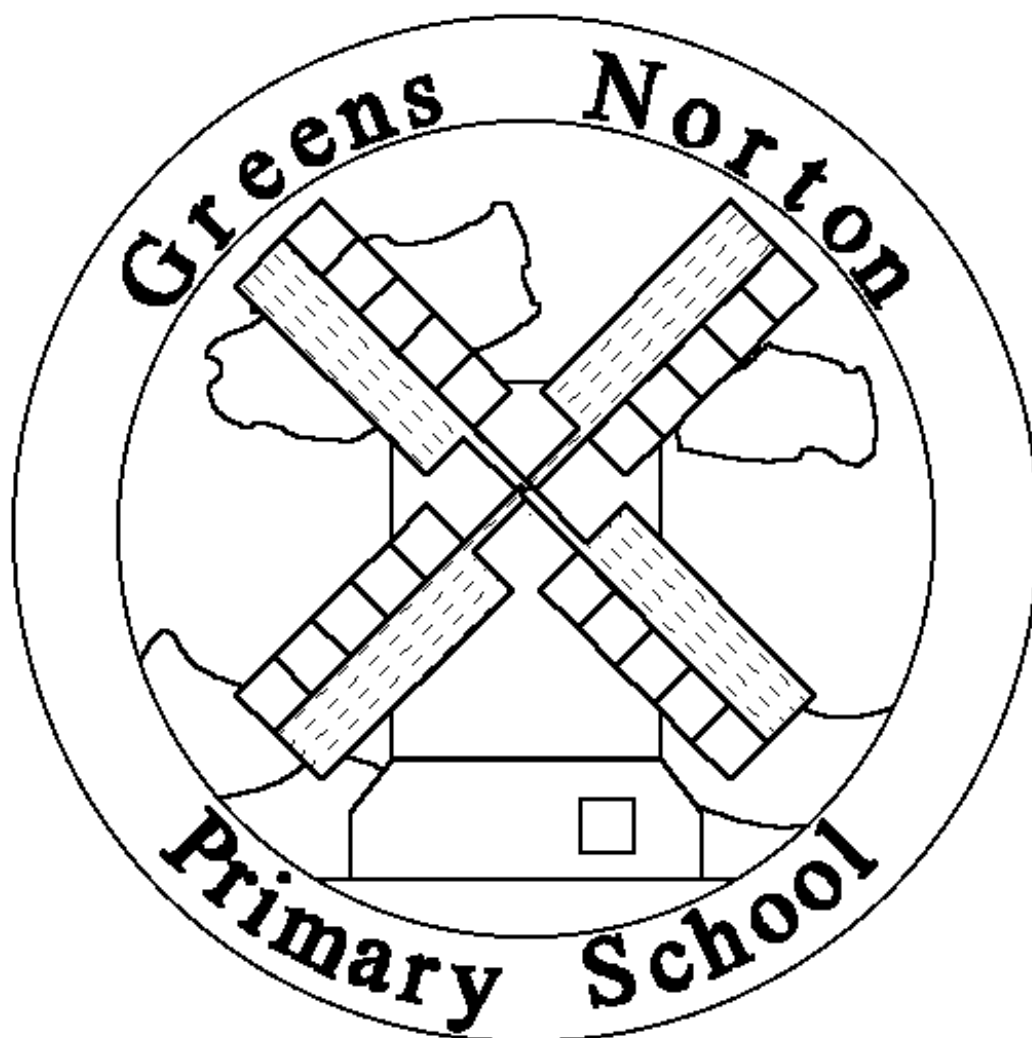

Policy for Charging

School Activities

The school will not charge pupils or their parents for educational or other activities within the school day, except for certain music tuition where charging is required by the LEA.

Voluntary contributions will be sought for trips and visits.

No pupil will be excluded from any activity because his/her parents do not make a contribution. However, if not enough parents contribute, it may be necessary to cancel the activity.

Organisations other than the School may charge for activities during school hours.

The level of contribution asked will be that required to recover all the school's costs in full.

Residential Courses

The School will not charge for the educational part of residential courses.

The School will charge for other aspects of a residential course, eg accommodation , meals, insurance.

Parents who are experiencing financial difficulty should discuss their circumstances with the Head Teacher who will exercise his/her discretion..

The level of charge will be calculated to recover all the school's costs equally from the number of pupils to whom charges are made.

Other Charges

The School will not charge for books, materials, participation in sports or music events, representing the school or playing in school teams.

External Charges

The School's policy for lettings is to charge a fair rate in accordance with LA Guidelines.

However, if the party charged is of clear benefit to the school (eg TASC) a reduced rate may be agreed. This reduced rate must be agreed by the Governing Body.
